The old town stretches around, with the Church of Panagia and the Lighthouse nearby.

Visit the impressive Imaret (1817) donated by Mehmet Ali, which originally functioned as an Islamic seminary and is now a luxury hotel. You can visit the common areas of Imaret by participating in one of the 30-minute guided tours that take place every half hour.

You consider Kavala the Mecca of tobacco. The city's Tobacco Museum is an extremely interesting museum with thematic sections documenting the modern journey of tobacco in the city. The collection includes tools for growing tobacco, machinery for its commercial processing, photographic material, rare documents.

Beaches...

Kavala has a wide variety of beaches with clear blue waters, where you can enjoy the sun, the sea and indulge in water sports. The most famous are: Perigiali, Rapsani, Kalamitsa, Batis, Tosca, Palio, Iraklitsa and Nea Peramos. Many of them have been awarded with blue flags.



At a distance of two kilometers from Nea Peramos, there is the well-known Ammolofoi beach, with a length of 3 kilometers. Its clear blue and crystal clear waters, as well as the sand inside and outside the water, are a pole of attraction. Ammolofi due to their waters are considered among the 10 best beaches in Greece. They are overwhelmed by countless beach bars, sunbeds and umbrellas for bathers.



After the dunes on the old Kavala – Thessaloniki National Highway, the whole Egnatia street is bathed by fantastic beaches and beach bars.



On the Eastern side of Kavala there is also the unique sand tongue of Keramoti with countless kilometers of emerald sea and many beach bars and taverns for good food. From here by ferry boat, Thassos is just a breath away.

It has one of the most important parks in Greece at the springs of Agia Varvara. There the visitor will find the peace and quiet of the countryside just a few meters from the city center.
